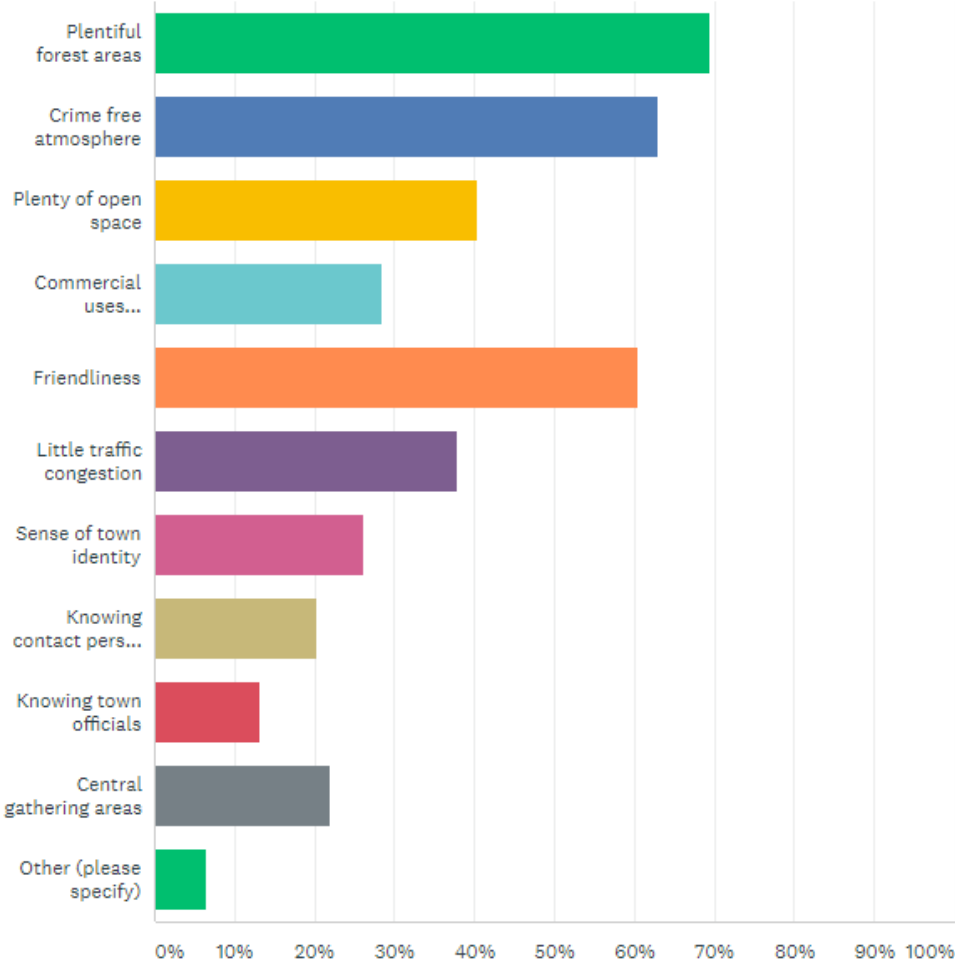

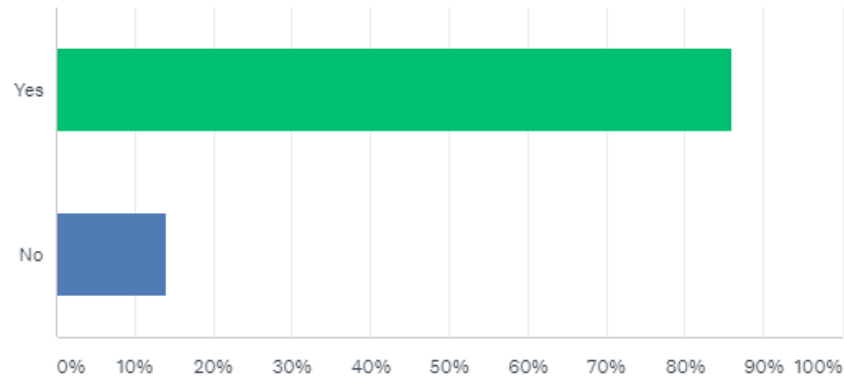
How do you usually find out about town events and meetings?

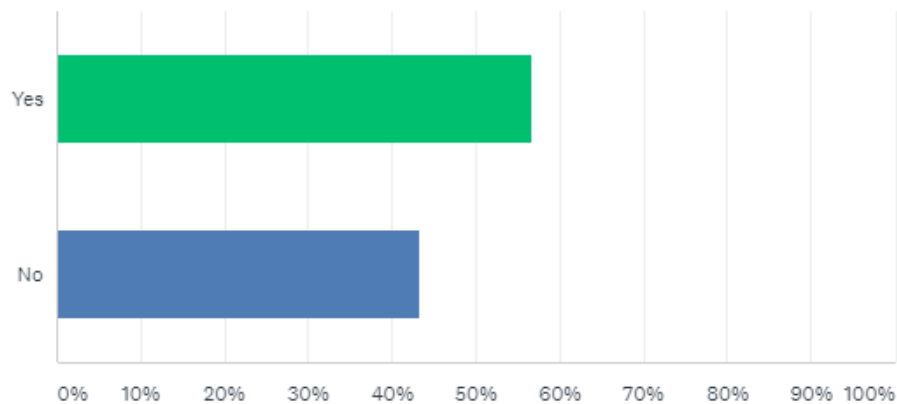

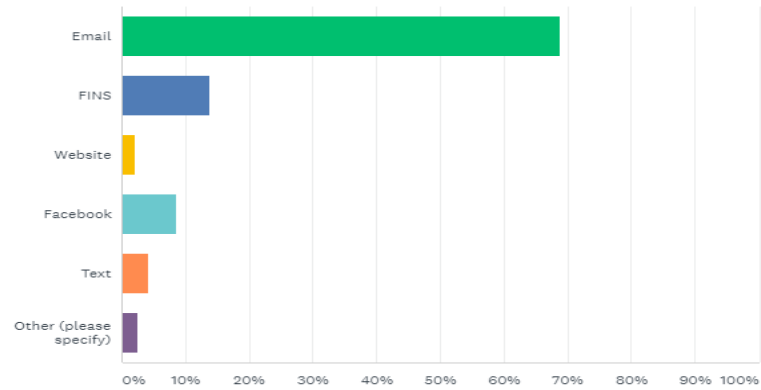
Should the town have an official Facebook page managed by the town?

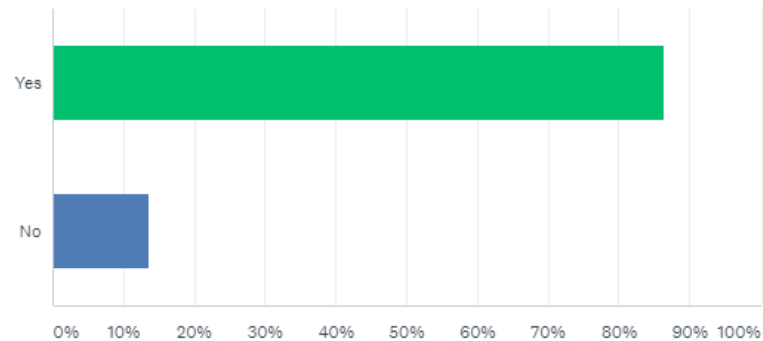
What is the best way to reach Frye Island citizens about important town meetings or events?

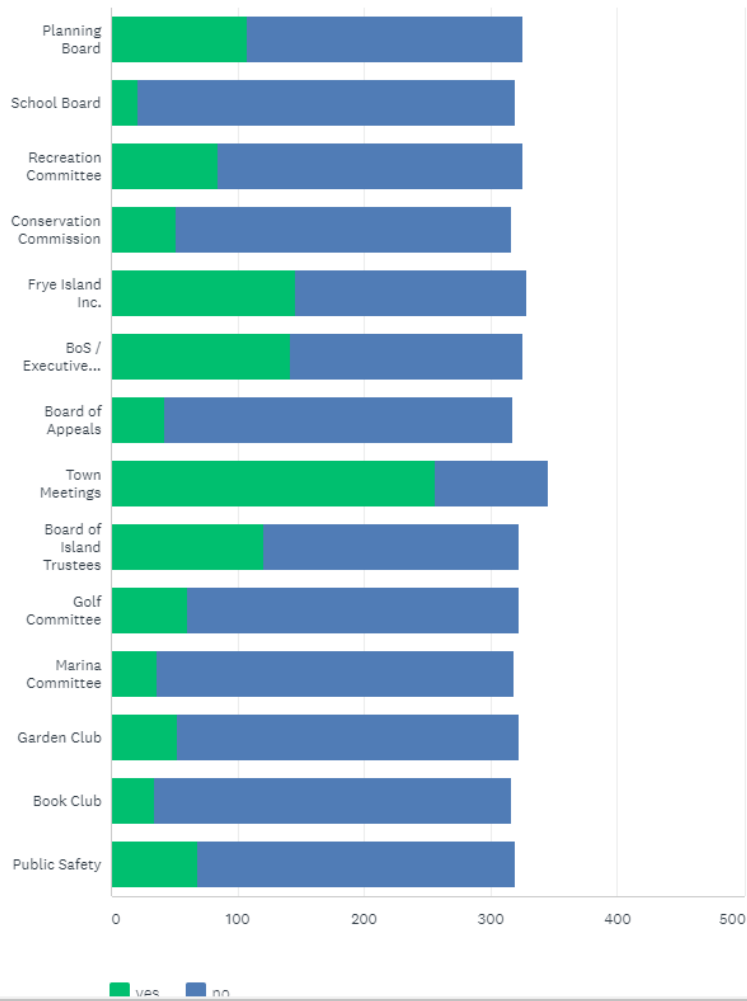
What is the best way for Town Officials to hear your concerns about important town issues?

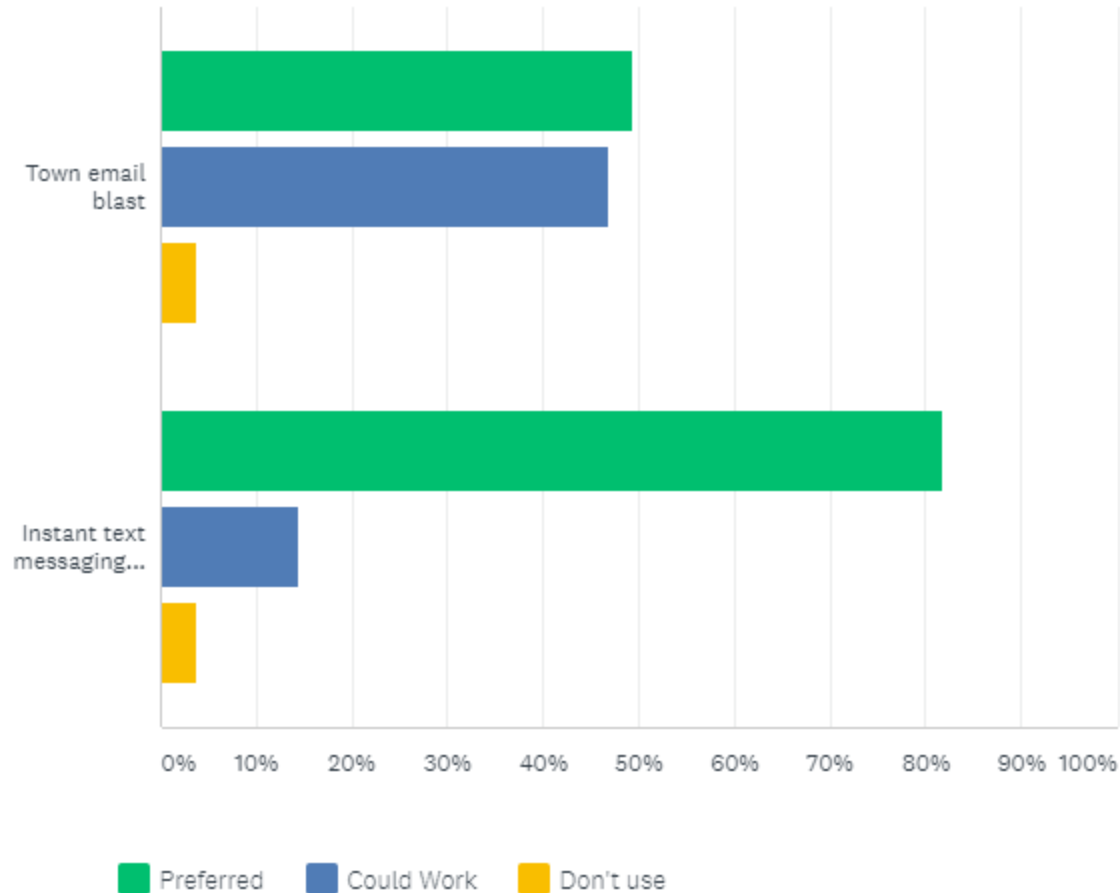

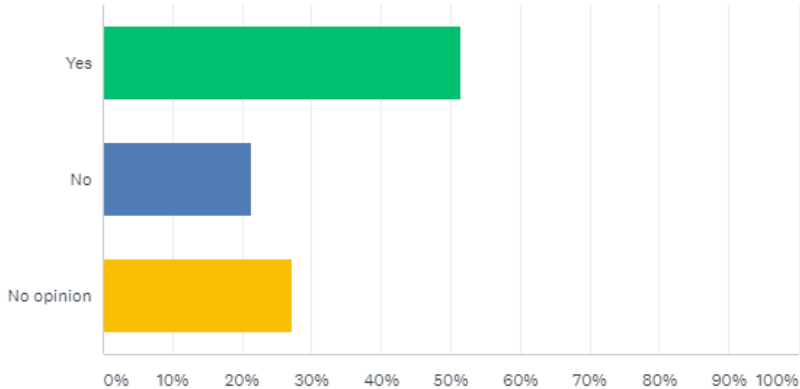

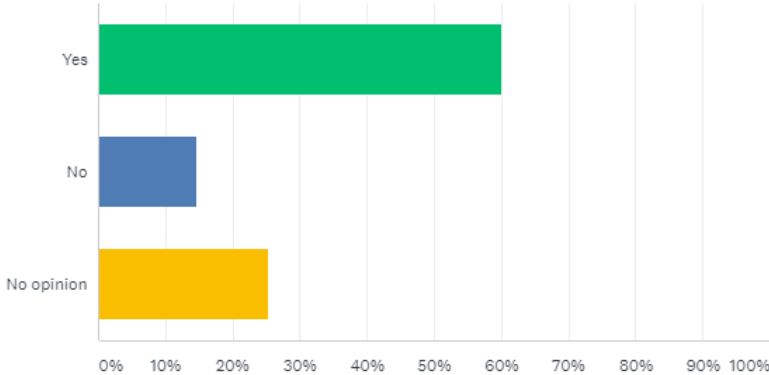
Should there be term limits with regards to committee appointments?

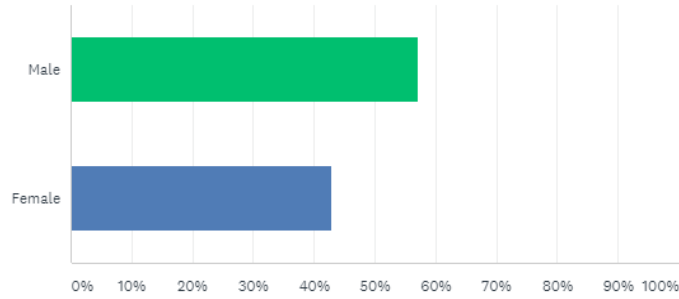
Should there be term limits with regards to the elected BOS/BIT Executive Committee?

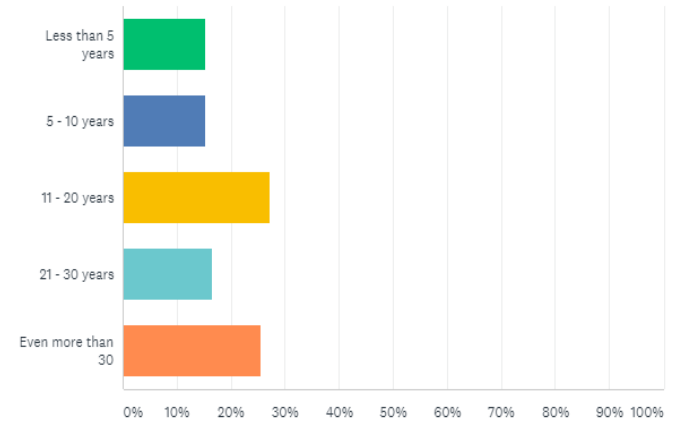
