

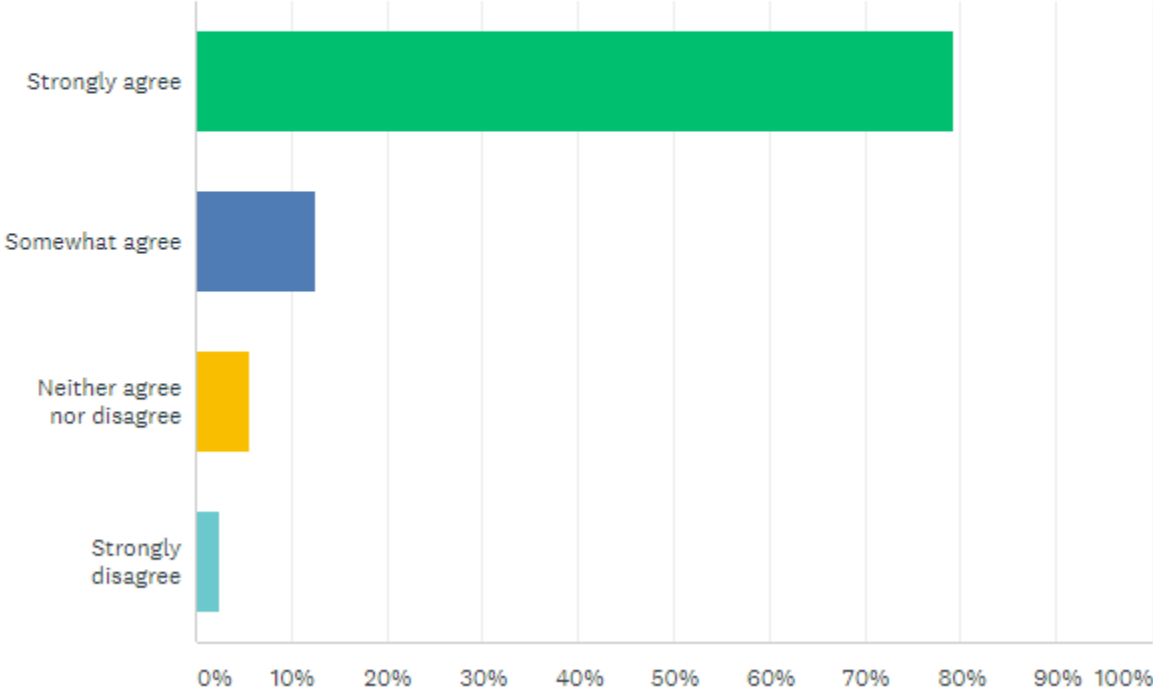

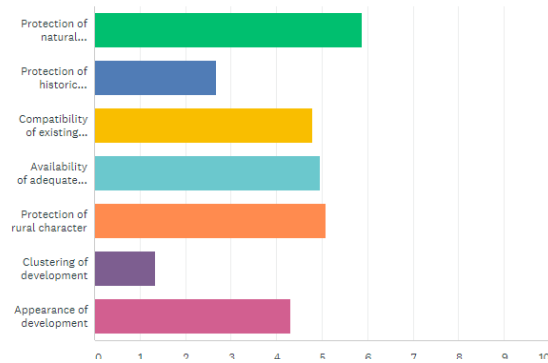
As housing development continues, do you agree that the town should identify significant existing scenic and natural resource areas for conservation, preservation and protection?

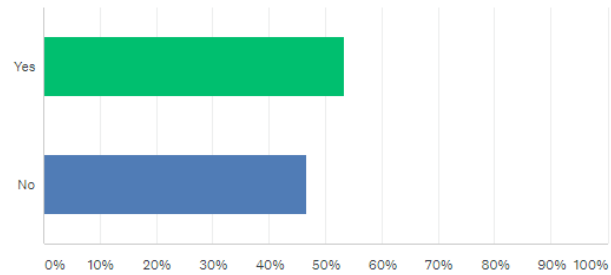

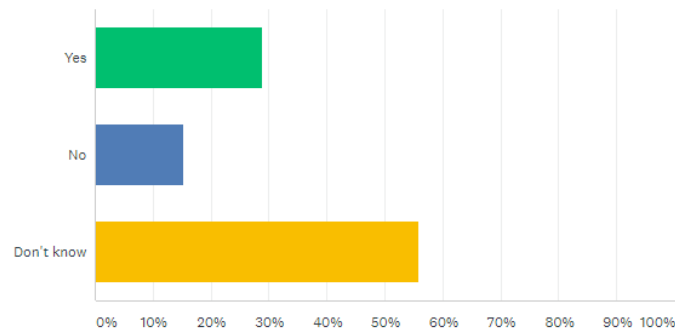
Should the town have a common area for the storage of private contractor construction equipment?

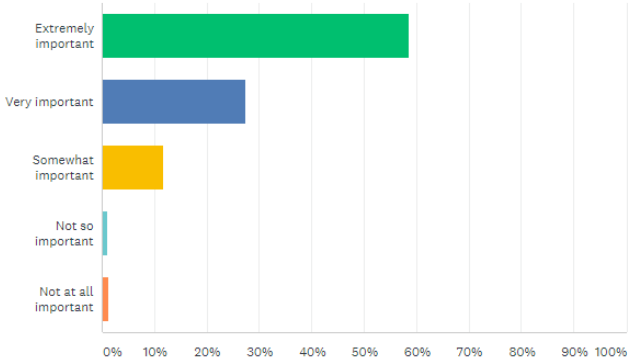
Are the current land use ordinances (found on the Frye Island web site) on Frye Island effective at promoting reasonable and efficient patterns of development?

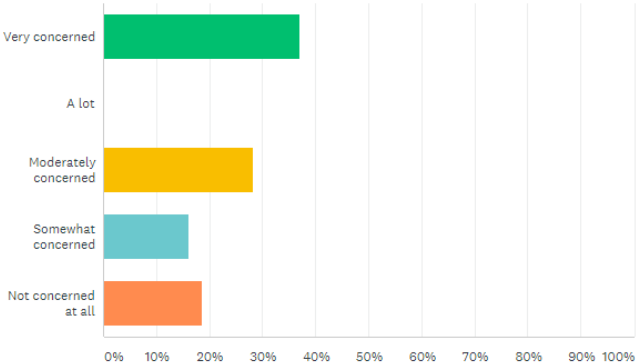
How important is it to preserve the trees and natural vegetation on the island?

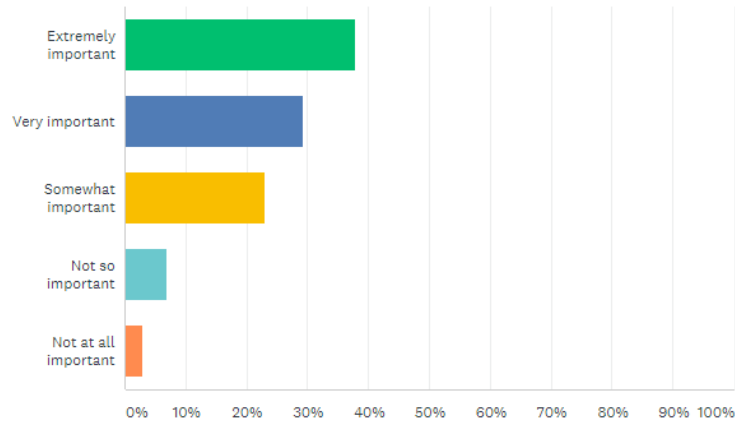
How concerned are you with the pace of new construction of homes on the island?

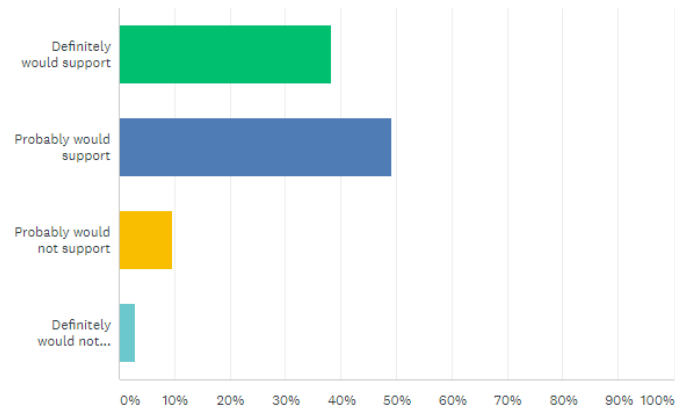
How important is it to you to limit the cutting of trees and vegetation in the new home construction process?

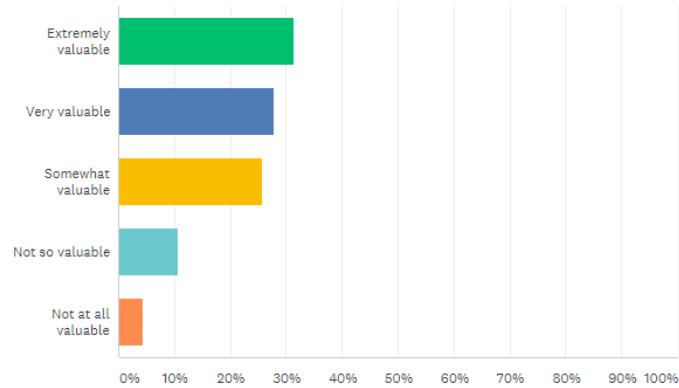

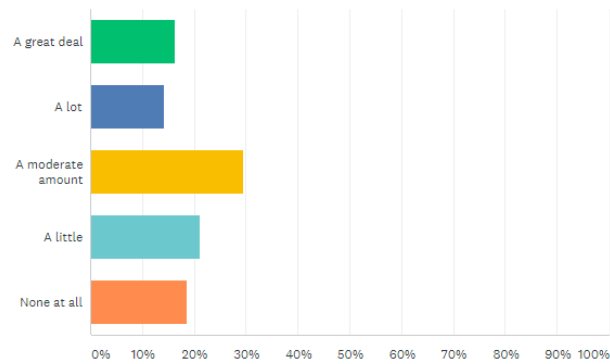
Would an enhanced system of connected woodlands trails and open space designated throughout the town be valuable to you?

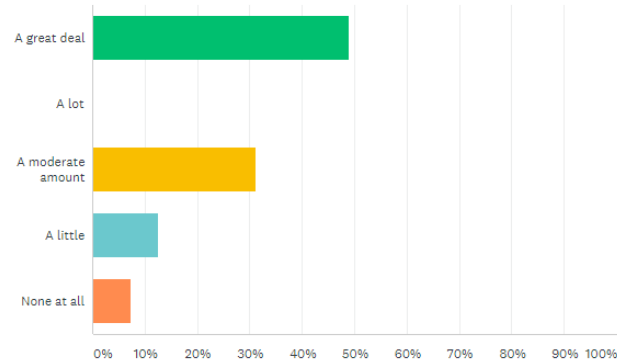
Do you feel that off-islanders use of recreational areas significantly interferes with Town residents use of recreational areas?

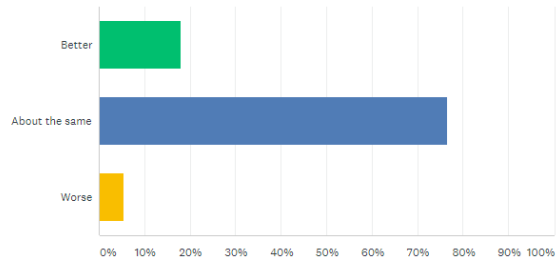
How concerned are you with the increasing amount of clear cutting of trees when a new house is built and the impact on the beauty and character of the island and the increased erosion and road damage?

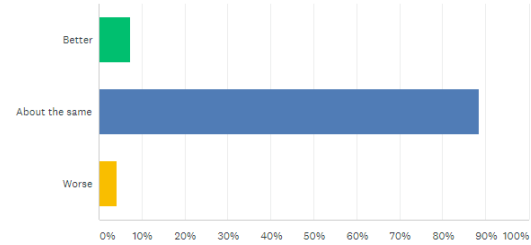
Have you noticed a change in water pressure in the past 5 years?

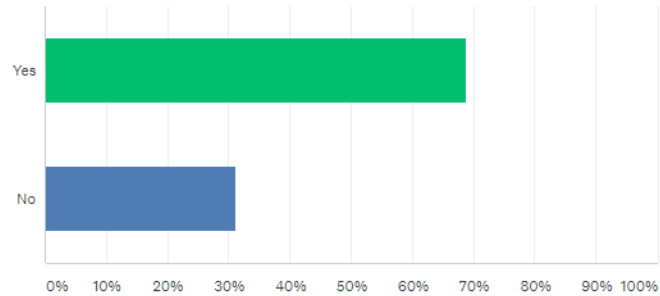
Have you noticed a change in drinking water quality in the past 5 years?

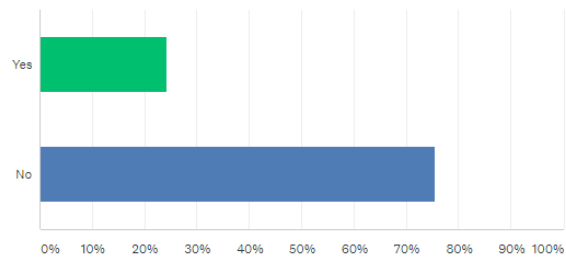
Should the island have a list of eco-friendly home builders?

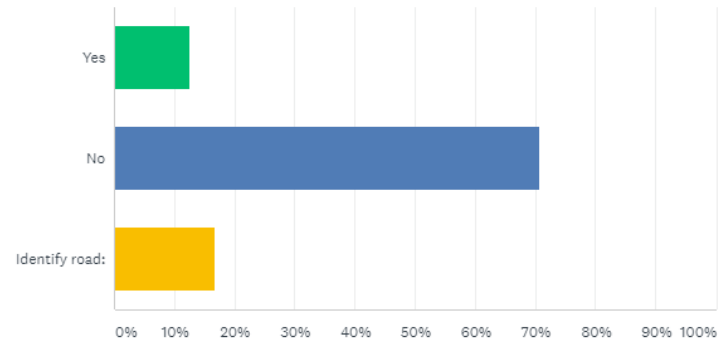

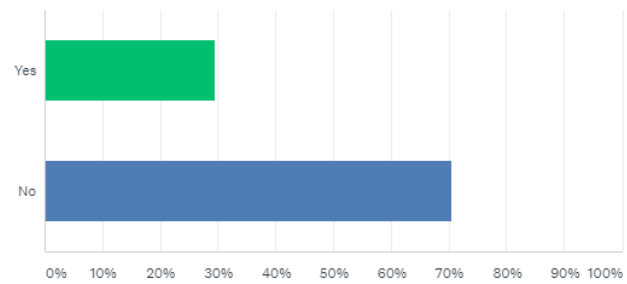
Are there any sections of town roads that need improvement? If yes, please identify.

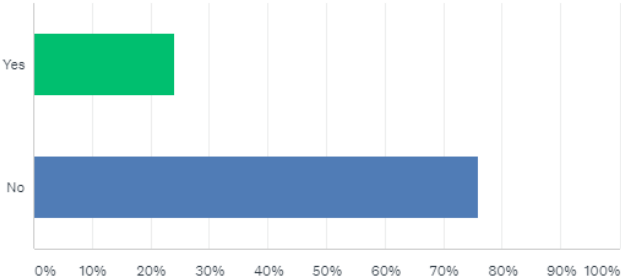
Would you like to see speed bumps in high speed areas?

Would you like to see some public transportation (bus, Van, UBER) available between the mainland ferry terminal and other communities?

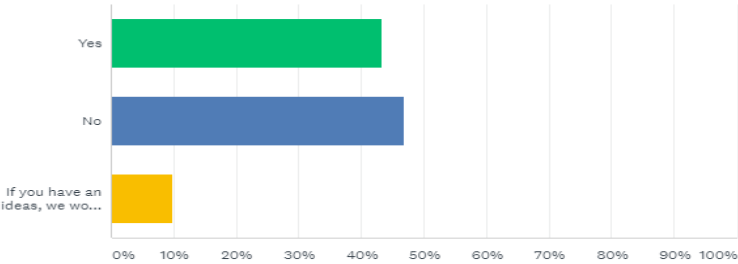
